For many people in India, the job they have to do to earn a living is very tough. Imagine people working in the brick kilns. The area is totally dusty and hot. The hot sun will also add fuel to fire. How do people work in this environment for more than 12 hours a day? If you ask them, they compare themselves with so many others, who don't even have this job! They are happy that they somehow have something to earn and take care of their families. Can they have their own home made of the bricks, which they make? No, they live only in huts, as home made of bricks are out their reach! It is not a question of 12 hours, it is a matter of many generations – yes, they are so poor that they can't think of educating their children and they also land up as brick kiln labourers.

Take the case of a person who works as a 'coolie' and his job is to lift heavy material and load it onto trucks. How the man manages to carry 75 to 100 KG bags on his back and effortlessly load in onto the truck! As he does these jobs for years continuously, his back tends to develop a curvature, and he can never stand straight. Can his next generation, stand straight and tall?

L.Vijaya Kumar, who secured the 1st position in Sevalaya's 12th grade exams, is from a brick kiln labourer family. He came in the Anna University merit list for engineering college admissions and Sevalaya has raised the money and paid his fees and he is proudly attending college now. He got seat in St. Peters Engineering College, he also got the group which is in demand – the IT group! In four years time, his family can afford a house made of bricks!

S.Nithya who secured 2nd position in Sevalaya's 12th grade exams, is from a 'truck loader' family. She has come in the merit list and Sevalaya has admitted her, in Sriram Engineering College in EEE group. Very soon, she will be standing tall and that too, on her own legs.

Many others have got admission in various other arts and science colleges, some of them in B.Sc. Computer science group. Higher education is very expensive and thanks to all of you, we have put 37 kids in colleges, who are from very poor background. Very soon, Sevalaya should be running its own free university, open for the orphan, poor and destitute bright children.
