Dear Friends,

A bus with few school girls is travelling in a lonely hilly road in the North West Pakistan. Suddenly some men appear from nowhere with AK 47 guns and stop the bus. The storm into the bus and brandish their guns and shout "Who is Malala?". There is complete silence. They shout again and again bringing the gun closer the girls. The girls are brave and they still keep quite. "If you don't identify Malala we will shoot down every one" — no reaction, again the girls are silent. Then the shooting happens and now Malala is recovering in a London hospital.

Malala, at the age of 11, started writing on social media networks about the plight of girls education in northern Pakistan – how they have been prevented from going to school, how the number of girls in each school went down day by day and how her school finally closed down. She had the courage to expose what was actually happening inside northern Pakistan, which many leading media channels failed to do.

After the shooting incident many Pakistani girls have come out in the open with placards "I am Malala". All over the world this little girl has become the symbol of girl child education.

When Sevalaya School started functioning two decades ago, we went from house to house asking poor parents to send their children to school. After lot of persuasion, they agreed to send only boys as they believed that even if education is offered free, it is not required for girls. We kept persuading and they kept giving reasons like lack of transportation, lack of toilet facilities for girls in schools, etc., Etc.

When we countered all their problems with solutions like, we will send our bus and do free pick up and drop, we will provide clean toilets separately for girls, we will take responsibility for their safety, etc., etc., still they were unwilling to send girls to school as in the heart of hearts, they strongly believed that education is not for girls. There were few parents who developed confidence in us and started sending girls to our school. So in the beginning there were more boys and fewer girls. As the parents saw the results, slowly the mindset changed and suddenly there was a rush of girls, with the result after five to six years, we had nearly 65% girls! Now that the "backlog is cleared", we have almost a 50:50 ratio.

There was no AK47 or terrorists in our villages physically, but it was all there in the mindset. To counter that, we didn't have to shoot down the terrorists, but we had to put in nearly two decades of sustained positive effort. Now girls are scoring top marks in 10^{th} and 12^{th} grade, many of them have gone for higher education. No girl is out of school in all the 32 villages around Sevalaya.

Help "Malala" by joining hands in the positive work.

Sevalaya joins in prayers with the rest of the world in wishing speedy recovery for Malala. In addition, we also pray for "speedy death of such fundamentalism".
